




Inventory levels flat in April

The number of vehicles available for consumers was effectively flat in April and remains higher than last year

UK: CarGurus Used Vehicle Availability Index*
January 2020 to April 2022



- Used inventory index increased by 0.005% from March.
- Year-over-year inventory increased with levels up 28.9%.





Prices continue to inch lower

The average listing price dropped slightly in April – however, prices remain up nearly 30% year-over-year

UK: Average used vehicle listing price
January 2020 to April 2022 (month end inventory, thousands £)




- The average used vehicle listing price decreased 2.6% from March.
- The year-over-year comparison showed prices up 29.5%.

Vehicles continue to sit for less time even with inventory gains

Even with recent improvements in inventory, vehicles continue to sit for fewer days-on-market when compared to last year

UK: Used average days-on-market January 2020 to April 2022



- Improving inventory levels led to days-onmarket increasing by 4.1% from March.
- Days-on-market remained lower on a year-over-year basis, with levels down 25.0%.
